



# ECAA SAFETY DECISION 2020-03 Date of Issue: March , 2020

SUBJECT:

FLEXIBILITY PROVISIONS DUE TO NOVEL CORONAVIRUS (Maintenance Engineer license , AMO , AOC , OTHER CERTIFICATES)

#### **APPLICABILITY:**

1- This Safety Decision shall be applicable for a period of three months from the date of issue, unless otherwise specified.

#### **INTRODUCTION:**

The socio-economic impact of the novel coronavirus is yet to be assessed. It has already resulted in drastic restrictions and arrangements preventing licensee holders from timely completing the necessary training, certificates of operations renewal procedures. As a result of the aforementioned unforeseen circumstances, the ECAA:

- a) found it necessary to reduce the severity of the disruptions; and
- b) would like presents today an immediate response to mitigate the socio-economic impact of the COVID-19 outbreak while assuring an acceptable level of safety.

This Safety Decision is issued with some of requirements to adopt additional provisions to:

- a) Provide flexibility to licensee holders when revalidating the privileges of their licenses .
- b) Defer the ECAA fee payments (limited to Aviation Safety Activities) for a period of 3 months .
- c) Allow issuance of approval or other authorizations by email or another method  $\, . \,$





DISCLAIMER: If any other flexibility provision is sought, organizations shall communicate the same to their principal inspector for future consideration.

## **REQUIREMENTS:**

#### REQUIREMENT NO. 1

For Aircraft maintenance licenses, approval and /or maintenance temporary approval issued in accordance with ECAR 65:-If the license, continuation training, approval and/or maintenance temporary approval expires during the period of this safety decision, considered valid for additional three months.

#### **REQUIREMENT NO. 2:**

Due to the current unforeseen circumstance, certificates or other authorizations may be processed by email . Ahmed.ead@civilavition.gov.eg ops@civilavition.gov.eg ECAA@civilaviation.gov.eg

## **REQUIREMENT NO. 3:**

Payment of fees related to ECAA services for aviation safety activities shall be deferred in period of this safety decision . and all fees will be paid after the end of this period.

## **REQUIREMENT NO. 4:**

## A- Certificate of airworthiness (ECAR 21.253):

- 1- All C of A certificate which will be expired during the period of this safety decision will be renewed for a period one year with limited flight permit for 3 months period.
- 2- Renewal process documentation phase will completed as ECAA policy and procedure manual.





- 3- After official letters from chief inspector that all bellows items must be attached and satisfactory:-
- AD's status for (aircraft / Engine / appliance /....).
- Time control items / life limit items .
- All checks according approved maintenance program .
- D.D.L status
- All related certificates are valid (AOC ,insurance radio license ,..)
- Aircraft Weight and balance not due
- Valid Fitness for flight for this aircraft.
- Flight test ( if required for C of A) renewal .
- Evidence for fees payment
- 4- The aircraft must be stopped after this period for inspection.

## b- Approved maintenance organization (AMO) (ECAR 145.7d)

- 1- All certificate which will be expired during the period of this safety decision will be considered valid for a extended period of three months after the date of expiry while ECAA assuring an acceptable level of safety.
  - 2- After official letters from quality manager that all bellows items must be attached and satisfactory:-
    - Authorization certifying staff list and scope of authorization including line, base and shops maintenances
    - Calibration tools status list.
    - Key personnel approval.
    - Internal audit plan and implementation status for 2019&2020.
    - Approval of most recent MOE/GMM revision.
    - Technical publication status .
  - Fulfill requirement No. 5:-

# c- Air operator certificate (AOC) (ECAR 121.29 & ECAR 101.5).

1- All certificate which will be expired during the period of this safety decision will be considered valid for a extended period of three





months after the date of expiry while ECAA assuring an acceptable level of safety .

- 2- After official letters from chief inspector that all bellows items MUST be satisfactory:-
- Airworthiness status for all company aircraft's.
- Key personnel's approval.
- Technical publication status with current design states revisions.
- Fulfill requirement No. 5:-
- d- <u>All other certificates / authorizations / approvals (Example ECAR 139.109, 138.109, 170.19, 171.131, 172.151, 174.13, 111.19, 112.19, 301.41, 303.87, 311.11, 603.4.7)</u>

which will be expired during the period of this safety decision will be considered valid for a extended period of three months after its expiry date while ECAA assuring an acceptable level of safety.

- After official letters that from Operator / service provider is
- Comply with all civil aviation requirements :-
- After provide any requested corrective or remedial action .
- Fulfill requirement No. 5:-
